Small rural projects

THE Therapeutic Goods Administration has added Janssen-Cilag's Prezista (darunavir) to its list of designated orphan drugs.

It's indicated for the treatment of HIV infection in children and adolescents aged 6 to under 18.

PHARMACISTS now have an explanation for those previously mysterious surges in business.

It's all due to what was on TV the previous night, according to Belgian researchers who have found that watching hospital dramas can make you worry more about your own health.

The scientists surveyed 1300 teenagers about their viewing habits and found that those who liked medical shows were more likely to be concerned about getting sick themselves.

THE Texan city of San Antonio has revealed that it plans to become the first major US metropolis to harvest methane gas from human waste on a commercial scale.

Residents of the city produce about 140,000 tonnes a year of "biosolids" which will be converted into natural gas and sold to power generators.

STINGOSE certainly wasn't enough for three people who were stung to death by bees after a truck carrying several dozen hives overturned in northeast China this week.

The accident happened near Changchun, with TV reports showing thousands of bees swarming around the vehicles as emergency workers wearing protective clothing attempted to clear the debris.

To make it even more tragic three more people were killed several hours later when two trucks collided as they tried to avoid the angry insects.
