NPS on COPD drugs

NPS has reviewed the newly listed indacaterol (brand name Onbrez) for people with chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD). Indacaterol is a once-daily long acting bronchodilator used to treat the symptoms of COPD, using an inhaler device called a Breezhaler.

The drug helps reduce shortness of breath and coughing, but is not suitable to treat people with asthma or mixed airways disease.

The review is one of three in-depth looks at newly listed medicines, including asenapine for bipolar I disorder and schizophrenia in NPS' latest Medicines Update.

NPS has recommended that anyone who is about to start indacaterol or asenapine read the reviews, and then have a discussion with their GP or pharmacist.

New simvastatin precaution

THE Therapeutic Goods Administration is warning health professionals about a series of new contraindications and precautions for the use of simvastatin.

Simvastatin is used to control elevated cholesterol or hypercholesterolemia after diet, exercise and weight loss efforts have failed, but has recently been found in high doses, and in those taking certain other medicines, to increase the risk of myopathy (muscle weakness) and, more rarely, rhabdomyolysis (the

breakdown of muscle fibres resulting in the release of muscle fibre contents into the bloodstream).

As a result, the TGA is advising health professionals to limit the prescribing of high dose simvastatin to 80mg/day.

In addition, concomitant administration of simvastatin with the following medicines is now contraindicated: gemfibrozil, cyclosporine and danazol, as well as potent CYP3A4 inhibitors, including: itraconazole, ketoconazole, posaconazole, HIV protease inhibitors, erythromycin, clarithromycin, telithromycin and nefazodone.

The TGA has also set in place precautions (such as lower recommended simvastatin doses) for patients taking: moderate inhibitors of CYP3A4; amiodarone; the calcium channel blockers: verapamil, diltiazem and amlodipine; fibrates other than gemfibrozil; niacin (greater than 1g/day) and colchicine.

THE TGA has published three new Australian Public Assessment Reports for prescription medicines (AusPARs).

The AusPARs cover Janssen-Cilag's induction therapy prior to high dose chemotherapy, Velcade (bortezomib); and Amgen Australia's osteoporosis therapy Prolia (denosumab); as well as Novartis' Lucentis (ranibizumab) for the treatment of neovascular (wet) age-related macular degeneration and visual impairment due to diabetic macular oedema.

Leonardo da Vinci's Mona Lisa may have needed serious medical attention after she was painted surrounded by dangerous animals, according to one US artist, Ron Piccirillo.

Piccirillo has hit the world stage with claims that he has cracked the mystery of Mona's smile, saying the painting is about envy.

The artist made the discovery after using "an old trick" of turning the painting on its side, which supposedly revealed the heads of a lion, ape and buffalo hovering around Mona.

Piccirillo also found a crocodile or snake coming out from her body, on the left hand side.

"I spent the next two months poring over da Vinci's journals and came across the passage on envy which for me sums up what this is about," Picirillo said.

The passage which Picirillo refers to says that when trying to paint envy one must "give her a leopard's skin, because this creature kills the lion out of envy and by deceit", which Picirillo says refers to the lion head supposedly in the painting.

Picirillo also said that the shading around her nose and eyes, which looks like a palm tree also confirms his envy hypothesis, with da Vinci having also added that envy should look "Wounded in the eye by a palm branch and by an olive-branch, and wounded in the ear by laurel and myrtle, to signify that victory and truth are odious to her".
