Dispensary Corner

THREE-YEAR-OLD Peyton from Cumbernauld, North Lanarkshire, had been suffering from sinus pain and lethargy for three months, scratching around her nose and complaining of discomfort.

Her parents, Craig and Kirsty, were baffled, despite several GP visits yielding no answers.

The mystery was finally solved at the Queen Elizabeth University Hospital (QEUH) in Glasgow, where ENT specialists discovered a raisin lodged in Peyton's nose.

Craig Handley, a former army medic, recounted on *BBC Radio's* Good Morning Scotland program how Peyton has had bad breath for months.

"We thought it was viral, kids catch everything," Handley said. Despite their best efforts, like using a torch to look up the nose, they couldn't find anything.

"We didn't have the right instruments to look properly."

As Peyton's symptoms persisted, her parents grew more concerned, leading them to the QEUH.

Within five minutes, the culprit was found: a raisin.

"You turn your back for two seconds, and they do what they want," Handley remarked, praising the hospital staff.

"The ENT guys were amazing, and they kept Peyton at ease and found the raisin quickly."

He advised other parents facing similar issues to consult a proper ENT specialist.

Peyton is now back to her normal, energetic self with Handley joking, "definitely no more raisins!".

Butler to present at PSA24

THE Federal Minister for Health and Aged Care, Mark Butler (**pictured**), will deliver the ministerial address at the Pharmaceutical Society of Australia's national conference, PSA24.

The event will also be attended by pharmacist and Assistant Minister for Mental Health and Suicide Prevention Emma McBride, and Shadow Minister for Health and Aged Care Senator Anne Ruston.

PSA National President A/ Prof Fei Sim highlighted the significance of Butler's address, which will provide insights into the recently announced PSA Strategic Agreement on Pharmacist Professional Practice.

"At this critical juncture for the pharmacy profession, the Minister's presence recognises the irreplaceable role pharmacists play in quality and safe use of medicines," said Sim.

The signing of the eighth Community Pharmacy Agreement and the PSA Strategic Agreement this week (*PD* 03 Jun) underscores the Federal Government's support for pharmacists' fundamental role in Australia's healthcare system, she explained.

"This is an important opportunity for our profession to hear directly from the Minister about the



government's policy agenda and priorities for the next 12 months and beyond," Sim commented.

"I call on all pharmacists and pharmacy students to attend the PSA24 Conference in Sydney as we continue our advocacy to expand pharmacists' roles, recognition and remuneration.

PSA24, themed 'Pathways to Progress,' will have over 40 educational sessions and opportunities to hear from both government and opposition representatives, offering pharmacists the chance to engage with industry leaders, policymakers, and colleagues nationwide.

Registration is now open for the conference to held from 02-04 Aug at the International Convention and Exhibition Centre in Sydney.

Vic pilot a success



SINCE Victoria's statewide community prescribing pilot launched in Oct last year, more than 10,000 people have been treated for a range of everyday conditions by their community pharmacist.

"Reaching the milestone is a clear demonstration of the trust that patients have in the highly-trained community pharmacists to provide safe, timely and quality care for everyday conditions and healthcare needs," said Megan Kazantzis, Pharmacy Guild of Australia's Victoria branch committee member.

Since the 12-month pilot began (*PD* 20 Oct 2023), more than 5,290 women with an uncomplicated UTI were treated with antibiotics.

Another 3,160 consultations were completed for the repeat supply of oral contraceptives.

More than 2,200 Victorians have also accessed travel health and other vaccines as part of the pilot in which over 760 pharmacies across the state took part.

"The numbers speak for themselves," said Kazantzis.

"The Victorian pharmacist prescribing pilot is a win for the thousands of patients who have already safely accessed treatment for these conditions at their local community pharmacy as well as practical step to relieve pressure on our over stretched GPs and emergency departments," Kazantzis concluded.

MediSecure in voluntary administration

ELECTRONIC prescriptions company, MediSecure, which suffered a large-scale cyber breach last month (*PD* 17 May), has entered voluntary administration and will face its creditors later this month.

The ASIC statement published this week said FTI Consulting's Vaughn Neil Strawbridge and Paul Stuart Harlond were appointed as voluntary administrators of MediSecure on 03 Jun, and liquidators of the company's subsidiary, Operations MDS, on 04 Jun.

The first meeting of creditors will be on 14 Jun at 11am AEST.
