Rural scholarships

FEDERAL Minister for Rural Health, Bridget McKenzie, yesterday launched the government's Health Workforce Scholarship Program, with \$11m available over three years to make health services more accessible for people in country areas.

Health professionals in rural and regional areas wanting to increase their skills are encouraged to apply for financial support under the program via their state or territory Rural Workforce Agency.

MedAdvisor expands PlusOne

LISTED medication adherence provider MedAdvisor has seen month-on-month growth of 24% since Jul 2017 in the number of pharmacies offering its PlusOne patient engagement software.

That in turn has seen professional services delivered by the platform grow by 43% per month, with PlusOne now featuring 40 programs including flu vaccinations, MedsChecks and programs relating to quality use of medicines.

An update from the company yesterday said PlusOne was the "leading patient engagement

software for Australian pharmacies," with a market share of more than 50% enabling patients to digitally connect with their pharmacy via app, online, SMS and interactive voice response systems for medication ordering and management.

CEO Robert Read said in the last quarter MedAdvisor continued to work closely with EBOS, with a commercial agreement with TerryWhite Chemmart expected to be finalised shortly.

Quarterly revenue was \$1.67 million and the number of patients per pharmacy grew 1.9% to 367.

SHPA backs TGA plan

A NEW protocol proposed by the Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA) to manage and communicate medicines shortages (PD 29 Mar) has received the support of the Society of Hospital Pharmacists of Australia (SHPA) in its submission to the consultation.

SHPA federal president Professor Michael Dooley says the proposed protocol - which has been informed by data gathered by SHPA members at a grassroots level - will provide important protections for Australian patients.

"These algorithms can be run against connected dispense databases and then notify the pharmacist which of their patients would be eligible for an individual professional service," da Gama said.
