No action for CWH staff

PHARMACISTS from a Brisbanebased Chemist Warehouse (CWH) will not face disciplinary action in relation to a dispensing error.

Wed 15th July 2020

The mistake saw a patient receive a double dose of his prescribed blood pressure medication following a triple bypass in a dose administration aid (DAA), the Courier Mail reported.

The patient reportedly discovered the pharmacists had dispensed an incorrectly packed DAA after feeling light-headed, fatigued and unsteady.

The man reported multiple falls, including one incident where he fell into a gully and narrowly missed hitting a rock.

The patient complained about the error to the Office of the Health Ombudsman, with the matter being referred on to the Pharmacy Board of Australia, who judged that there was no need to take action against the two pharmacists who had dispensed the medication. In its response to the complaint

pharmacist involved in the case had "shown insight into his performance", with the store taking steps to implement new packing processes, including requirements to document packing and have a second pharmacist conduct checks of DAA prior to dispensing.

the Board noted that the senior

The patient described the Board's decision as "outrageous" and a "travesty".

"It only took a few days from making my complaint for Chemist Warehouse to order sweeping changes, 17 in total, in the way it dispenses and checks medications," he said.

"It took six months and a mountain of correspondence since Dec 2019 with the Office of Health Ombudsman, the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency, the National Health Practitioner Ombudsman and Privacy Commissioner and the Pharmacy Board, for the board to give its final no-appeal decision".

Pharmacy flu jab jump

SOME tasks are better left to the experts no matter how simple they may appear.

A few months ago many members of the public would have assumed putting on a surgical mask was easy.

But as you've no doubt witnessed a sizeable portion of the population are struggling to ensure masks cover their nose and mouth.

So Federal Health Minister, Greg Hunt, stepped up to the plate to demonstrate how it's done, but sadly his effort to ensure the members of the public were aware that the masks are more than mere chin coverings only served to prove he made a wise decision in not pursuing a career as a surgeon, or indeed a flight attendant, as he bungled his display struggling to attached the mask to his ears in a **VIDEO**, before managing to cover his eyes with it.

Acutely aware of his less than stellar efforts Hunt sought some professional assistance to give Australians a better example of how to use a surgical mask without turning it into a blindfold, recruiting his wife, Paula, who has previously worked as a theatre nurse, to produce a more effective **VIDEO**.



DATA from Amcal and Guardian pharmacies reveals demand for pharmacist-administered influenza vaccines surged 179% in Mar and Apr compared to the same period in 2019.

A THIEF who stole more than \$1,000 worth of Swisse vitamins from two Victorian Chemist Warehouse stores will spend two months behind bars.

Heidelberg Magistrates Court heard Christopher Edward Smyth had been caught shoplifiting five times in the space of a month, targeting Chemist Warehouse stores in Bundoora and Heidlberg West, and a Dan Murphy's in Preston, where he stole alcohol worth \$209.

When stopped by a Coles Express employee in Bundoora, attempting to walk away with a coffee, a chicken sandwich and an Up and Go, Smyth apologised saying, "Sorry, I can't pay, I don't have any money".
